CPR/AED First Aid Training Class

We will be holding a CPR / AED / First Aid Training class on Monday, June 12th here at Trinity. This class is an American Red Cross course and will be led by Tom Larson who has extensive experience in this training.

For those wanting an official 2 year Red Cross certification, the cost of the class is \$19 a person. For those just wanting an awareness, the class will be free. To cover all the material in this new 2016 standards class, the length is 4 hours which we will do in one night (6pm – 10pm). 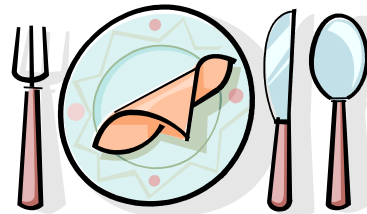

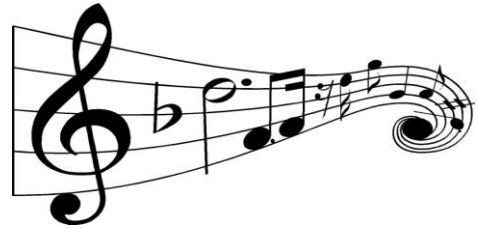
